I am requesting funding for the City of Brea Active Transportation Program.

The entity to receive funding for this project located at 1 Civic Center Cir, Brea, CA 92821.

The funding would be used to improve the railroad corridor along Orange County Loop Segment B; known to the City as the Tracks at Brea Western Extension. It will help the City acquire a 120 feet cross section of abandoned rail corridor to later construct a paved pedestrian trail adjacent to an existing Union Pacific Railroad line between Palm Street and Brea Canyon Flood Channel, helping close a gap in the 66-mile OC Loop.
