I am requesting funding for the California State University, Fullerton Pedestrian Bridge.

The entity to receive funding for this project is California State University, Fullerton, located at 800 N State College Blvd, Fullerton, CA 92831.

The funding would be used to construct a pedestrian bridge spanning a key campus crossing at Nutwood and Commonwealth Avenues. The bridge would protect pedestrians, mitigate neighborhood concerns by reducing vehicle trips, improve traffic flow along one of the city's busiest routes, and ultimately encourage safe walking and biking. CSUF serves over 40,000 students and is the most populous campus in the California State University system.
