I am requesting funding for the City of Anaheim Emergency Operations Center Relocation Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Anaheim, located at 200 S. Anaheim Blvd., Anaheim, CA, 92805.

The funding would be used for modifying an existing structure in Anaheim that will serve as the City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC), allowing the EOC to relocate from its current facility, which is no longer structurally sound and lacks adequate space to conduct emergency operations.
