Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Mohler Loop Fire Access Road Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Anaheim, located at 200 S. Anaheim Blvd., Anaheim, CA 92805.

The funding would be used for construction of a fire access road in the Mohler Loop neighborhood of Anaheim Hills by converting and upgrading an existing pedestrian pathway to accommodate emergency vehicles. Improvements will include widening and reinforcing the pathway, grading and surface stabilization, drainage upgrades, installation of retaining walls and fencing repairs, and related site improvements to ensure reliable emergency access. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve emergency access and evacuation routes in a wildfire-prone residential area with limited entry points. Federal investment will strengthen public safety infrastructure by helping first responders reach homes more quickly during wildfires, medical emergencies, and other disasters affecting residents of California's 40th Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 42 U.S.C. §5305(a)(2) – the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or installation of public works, facilities, and site improvements.
