Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Fire Stations Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Orange, located at 300 E. Chapman Avenue, Orange, CA 92866.

The funding will be used to complete facility improvements at Fire Stations 7 and 8 through roof replacement and exterior painting. These upgrades will address aging building components to protect the stations from weather damage and deterioration. The project will preserve the structural integrity and operational readiness of these critical emergency response facilities. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it preserves critical public safety infrastructure that supports emergency response services for the community. Replacing aging roofs and rehabilitating exterior building components will protect the facilities from deterioration and help ensure reliable operations for firefighters and paramedics. Investing in preventative maintenance of emergency response facilities helps avoid more costly repairs while supporting uninterrupted public safety services.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. § 5305(a)(2) and (a)(4).
