Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Mobile Command Post Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Tustin, located at 300 Centennial Way, Tustin, CA 92780.

The funding will be used to acquire a new Mobile Command Post to replace the Police Department's existing 25-year-old unit and strengthen emergency response capabilities. The project will fund the purchase and outfitting of a fully equipped mobile command vehicle with integrated communications systems, mobile data connectivity, and workstations to support incident command and interagency coordination during emergencies. The new unit will improve field-based command operations and situational awareness during natural disasters, major incidents, and large public events. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it replaces aging emergency response infrastructure with modern equipment that supports effective incident command and multi-agency coordination. A mobile command post with integrated communications and data systems will improve real-time coordination among law enforcement, fire, and emergency management personnel during disasters and major incidents. Strengthening emergency response capabilities helps protect lives, property, and critical infrastructure across the region.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. §10381(b)(9)), which authorizes the Department of Justice to support law enforcement technology and equipment that improves public safety and operational effectiveness.
