I am requesting funding for the Integrated Wellness & Chronic Care Center in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Hurtt Family Health Clinic, Inc, located at 1 Hope Drive, Tustin, CA 92782.

The funding will be used to renovate a 1800 sq ft clinical space for an integrated specialty care area that includes optometry exam lanes, exam rooms, diagnostic lab, care coordination offices, and a centralized nurse station. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it expands preventive care and coordinated management of chronic diseases that are major drivers of healthcare costs in America. Early detection and integrated care services for conditions such as diabetes can reduce preventable complications, hospitalizations, and long-term medical expenses. Supporting community health centers that provide cost-effective preventive care helps improve health outcomes while reducing strain on the broader healthcare system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 330 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. §254b), which authorizes the Health Resources and Services Administration to support Federally Qualified Health Centers in expanding access to primary care and preventive health services for medically underserved populations.
