Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Replacement of Fire Station 10 in Yorba Linda in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Orange County Fire Authority, located at 1 Fire Authority Road, Irvine, CA 92602.

The funding would be used for the demolition of the existing Orange County Fire Authority Fire Station 10 in Yorba Linda and construction of a new approximately 15,000-square-foot fire station with expanded apparatus bays and operational space for emergency response personnel. The project also includes temporary station facilities to maintain emergency services during construction and updated infrastructure to support current fire and emergency response needs. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will replace aging emergency response infrastructure that no longer adequately supports current population levels and emergency call volumes in Yorba Linda. Federal investment will help modernize critical public safety facilities and ensure first responders have the space and resources needed to effectively serve residents of California's 40th Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 42 U.S.C. §5305(a)(2).
