I am requesting funding for the San Bernardino County Emergency Command Trailer in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is San Bernardino County, located at 385 North Arrowhead Avenue, San Bernardino, CA 92415.

The funding will be used to procure and outfit a mobile emergency command trailer to support on-scene incident management during emergencies. The self-contained unit will include interoperable communications systems, secure data connectivity, and workstations for unified command staff to coordinate multi-agency response operations. The trailer will strengthen field-based emergency coordination during disasters such as wildfires, earthquakes, floods, and severe storms that impact the region. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it strengthens emergency response coordination and incident command capabilities in a region vulnerable to large-scale disasters. A mobile emergency command trailer will support interoperable communications and multi-agency coordination during incidents such as wildfires, floods, and other emergencies. Improving field-based command and control helps accelerate response operations, enhance public safety, and support effective coordination among local, state, and federal partners.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes aligned with section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
